The journey then continues to the vast plains of Serengeti National Park, home to big cats, wildebeest, zebras, and the world-famous Great Migration. The final major highlight is Ngorongoro Crater, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the world's largest intact caldera, where travellers can see a dense concentration of wildlife including lions, elephants, hippos, and the rare black rhino. This itinerary is ideal for travellers who want a compact Tanzania safari with strong wildlife viewing, classic game drives, and memorable landscapes within a short timeframe.

Enjoy a game drive before continuing to Mto wa Mbu for the night.

## **Day 2**                      **Mto wa Mbu to Serengeti National Park**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Serengeti campsite or lodge

After breakfast, depart from Mto wa Mbu and continue to Serengeti National Park. Enter the famous endless plains and enjoy a game drive through one of Africa's richest wildlife areas. Look out for lions, cheetahs, wildebeest, zebras, and other animals that make the Serengeti a world-renowned safari destination. Spend the night in the Serengeti.

## **Day 3**                      **Serengeti to Ngorongoro Conservation Area**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Accommodation: Ngorongoro campsite or lodge

Continue exploring the park before travelling towards the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Along the route, enjoy changing scenery and the diversity of Tanzania's landscapes before settling near Ngorongoro for the night.

## **Day 4**                      **Ngorongoro Crater to Arusha**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

The crater supports a dense wildlife population, including lions, elephants, hippos, and the rare black rhino. After exploring the crater floor and enjoying the views from the rim, return to Arusha where the safari concludes.

### **What destinations are included in this 4 days Tanzania safari?**

The safari includes Tarangire National Park, Serengeti National Park, Ngorongoro Crater, Mto wa Mbu, and departure or return through Arusha or Moshi.

### **What is the best time for this 4 days Tarangire, Serengeti, and Ngorongoro safari?**

The dry season from June to October is generally considered the best time because wildlife often gathers around water sources, making animals easier to spot. The wet season from November to May can also be rewarding because the parks are greener and less crowded.

---

### **What wildlife can I see on this safari?**

Travellers may see elephants, giraffes, lions, cheetahs, wildebeest, zebras, hippos, rhinos, and many bird species, depending on the season and wildlife movement.

### **What is included in the 4 days Tanzania safari price?**
